



Shuffle the Mania Cards your child is working on along with some BANG cards and place them face down on the table. Use as many or as few BANG cards as you like.

- Have your child turn over a card from the table.
- If she can read the word on the card, she wins that card and she can keep it.
- If she can't read the word, read it to her, but put the card back on the table and mix the cards around so the replaced card isn't easily identifiable
- Now, you turn over a card from the table.
- Show it to your child and read it so she hears the word. Then you keep that card.
- Take turns until all the cards are gone from the table.
- The one with the most cards at the end of the game, is the winner

If one of you turns over a "BANG" card, then you, the parent, must return all of your cards - mix them in with the others face down on the table. Only the parent returns cards - the child always keeps the cards she has won. This makes it very likely that the child will be the winner, so make sure you're not a sore loser!
