



Before You Start

- Select the Mania Cards for the words that your child is practicing.
- Shuffle the selected Mania Cards along with some of the Winning-Heart cards before placing them face down on the table. You may use as many or as few Winning-Heart cards as you like.

How To Play

- Have your child turn over a card from the table.
- If he can read the word on the card, he wins that card and keeps it.
- If he can't read the word, then you read it aloud, and you win that card.
- Now, it's your turn to turn over a card from the table. Show it to your child and read it so that he hears the word. Then you win that card.
- Take turns until all the cards are gone from the table.

The twist happens when one of you turns over a Winning-Heart card:

- If the Winning-Heart card is pink, your child steals a card from the cards you have won, and if he can read it, he gets to keep it. If he can't read it, you win it back.
- If the Winning-Heart card is purple, your child can steal 2 cards from your winnings, and if he can read **both** cards, he gets to keep them. If not, you win them back
- (Put the Winning-Heart card in a discard pile - don't return it to the table).

The one with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
